QHS Student Parking Contract

Parking for Quincy High School students is a privilege that is gladly offered to our students who are in good standing. We have two parking lots available for students. One is located on Coddington Street across from the YMCA. The other is in the rear of the school off of Russell Park. In order to receive a parking pass, students and a parent/guardian must complete and sign this contract and return to the Security Office with the fee listed below. ***Parking passes are non-transferrable.***

Students are required to follow the rules and guidelines below and if not followed can result in the loss of this privilege and could be subject to ticketing and/or towing at the owner's expense.

Students must:

1. Park in designated student parking areas.
2. Not exceed 5 miles/per hour in the lot.
3. Report to school on-time.
4. Parking passes must be hung on the rear view mirror facing forward.
5. When entering the rear parking lot use the Tennis Court entrance.

***PLEASE NOTE THAT A PARKING PASS DOES NOT ENSURE A PARKING SPOT IN THE TWO LOTS THAT ARE AVAILABLE AT THE SCHOOL – ARRIVING TO SCHOOL IN A TIMELY MANNER WILL GREATLY ENHANCE YOUR CHANCES.**
